This story walk is a half kilometre trail with themed areas to explore and discover. It is suitable for strollers. The trail includes the Hobbit House, the troll bridge, the Secret Garden, a Harry Potter moment, Charlotte's Web and elephants, tiger and zebra of the Jungle Book stories and Animalia.

As you walk around the trail there are many things to engage the imagination and enchant the eye. Birds are everywhere at Carrick Hill: black & white cockatoos, parrots, herons, ducks and maggies.
